As I Am shines with an honesty that is reflected in Karen Jacobsen's pure, simple voice and piano playing. There is a somber tone to the CD, but Australian-born Karen writes and sings purely from the heart. With lyrics as truthful as "I wanna be somewhere else doing something else with somebody else," it is easy to understand what it's like to be let down gently but to still feel deeply. Picking up where Lilith Fair left off, Karen Jacobsen is part of UrbanMuse NYC, a collective of female singer-songwriters. Karen's signature piece "Don't Miss You" has the line "I can't pretend something that's not real," and even though the song is about the end of a relationship, it's easy to feel that the song captures the virtue of Karen Jacobsen.
